## Stamps With A Message

These activities take little or no preparation!

### **TALKING HEADS**

#### You will need:

- a selection of stamps
- paper
- pens
- glue



Do you like my hair?



Frankly, I'd rather be BALD!

#### What to do:

- 1. Find some stamps with interesting or funny pictures on them.
- 2. Use your imagination to invent some things that the people or things on the stamps might be saying.
- 3. Make up a conversation between characters on the same stamp, or make one stamp talk to another!

Whoops... I think I've split my pants!



## MAKE YOUR COAT OF ARMS

#### You will need:

- paper
- coloured pencils or felt-tip pens
- a variety of stamps
- glue
- scissors (optional)





#### What to do:

- 1. Choose five or six stamps that have particular interest or meaning for you.
- 2. Use the stamps to form part of a coat of arms.
- 3. Colour in your design before you glue on the stamps.
- 4. You may wish to write why you chose particular stamps, for example,
- 'I chose the Sydney to Hobart race stamp because I love sailing' or
- 'I care about the environment, that's why I chose this beautiful bird stamp'.
- 5. When your coat of arms design is complete, you may want to cut it out so that it looks more like a shield.
