Fun with Stamps – 7

Stamp Your Stamp...

This is a fun activity where you make patterns using a potato as a stamper. (An adult needs to be helping with this activity.)

You can use your stamper potato to make gift paper, gift cards, or just an interesting picture.

You will need:

- a potato
- a pencil
- · a kitchen knife
- paint (blue, red, yellow)
- saucers or polystyrene meat trays, one for each colour of paint
- large sheets of paper

Here's what you do:

- 1. Cut your potato in half carefully so that the cut surface is straight.
- 2. With a pencil, draw a very simple shape on your potato such as a square, rectangle, triangle.
- 3. Carefully cut around that shape with a knife. Leave the shape intact but cut off the area around your shape. This will leave the shape sticking up.
- 4. Now press your potato gently into the paint. Try not to put too much paint on your stamper.
- 5. You are ready to print! Remember, you can print anything you want with just one shape or you could make a few different shapes.
